- Algebraic Analysis, Operational and Convolutional Calculi
- Generalized Functions, Harmonic Analysis
- Numerical and Approximation Methods, Computational Procedures and Algorithms, related to the Primary FCAA topics
- Fractional Stochastic Processes
- Fractal and Integral Geometry (*iff* related to FC)

Applications of these techniques to:

- Differential and Integral Equations, Problems of Mathematical Physics
- Control Theory, Mechanics, Probability and Statistics, Finances, Engineering, Biomedicine, etc.

Other contributions:

• Iff revealing connections between FC and the above-mentioned topics to model problems of the real physical and social world
